Highlights of 2013

U.S. Government

- Provided informational briefings to Congress and the Helsinki Commission
- Facilitated meetings for "World without Nazism" NGO with Members of Congress and staff
- Delivered lectures at Foreign Service Institute about Eurasian Jewry
- Held regular consultations with National Security Council senior staff members
- Provided advice to key State Department officials
- Arranged meetings with U.S. ambassadors for member agencies
- Senior NCSJ staffer named by President Obama as Chair of Commission for the Preservation of America's Heritage Abroad

Ukraine

- Met with MPs and party leaders to demand action against the anti-Semitic Svoboda party
- Published opinion piece on dangers of ultranationalism
- Arranged meetings with national government officials for member agencies
- Coordinated and chaired meeting for NCSJ constituency with Minister of Foreign Affairs
- Gave presentation on anti-Semitism in the region at international conference

Azerbaijan

- Co-authored letter of support to U.S. Helsinki Commission
- Led leadership mission to Azerbaijan
- Published widely distributed "think piece" on Azerbaijan and Israel

Russia

- Consulted with U.S. State Department and Embassy in Moscow about NGOs, religious freedom, and adoption ban
- Spoke at AIPAC conference about Russia-Israel relations
- Monitored ultranationalist and antiminority rhetoric in Russian media

Poland

- Spoke at European Jewish Heritage conference in Krakow
- Took part in Warsaw Ghetto uprising 70th anniversary remembrance
- Attended opening of the new Jewish History Museum in Warsaw
- Presented at annual assembly of U.S. Honorary Consuls General
- Worked for passage in U.S. Congress of visa waiver for Polish citizens

Programs and Publications

- Initiated educational program for young Eurasian diplomats about European and American Jewish history and U.S. civil society
- Chaired Ambassador Forums at semi-annual NCSJ Board of Governors meetings
- Published Weekly News Update, quarterly Insider Letter, and 2012 Annual Report, with a special section on contemporary Jewish faces in Eurasia

International Activities

- In Jerusalem, co-chaired working group on Eurasia and Eastern Europe at Global Forum on Combating Anti-Semitism
- Participated in Conference of Presidents of Major American Jewish Organizations annual overseas mission
- Served as resident scholar for Philadelphia Jewish Federation mission to Russia
- Held regular consultations with Eurasian ambassadors and embassy staff
- Consulted with Conference of European Rabbis on kosher slaughter and circumcision bans
- Participated in consultations, interventions, and meetings at 68th Session of the UN General Assembly
